Chicago, IL has served as the venue for this exploration for over two decades and continues to offer the cutting edge of contemporary architectural expression and construction opportunities while providing a broad array of professional practices which enthusiastically host our students during this experience. The group meets several times during the semester to develop a background understanding of the history and architectural traditions of the city. Class lectures and materials will help each student take personal advantage of this exposure.

There is a fee associated with this course.
